The Applicant and Burial Right Holder must abide with all rules or regulations that may apply to the Burial on Private Property. Council may vary its rules and regulations at any time and in any manner deemed necessary.						
On the death of the Burial Right Holder, the authority acting on behalf of the deceased must inform Council of the proposed burial date.
