CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL:

The Approved Licence Holder must:

1. Ensure that the gate or grid complies with the requirements of the Local Laws of Fraser Coast Regional Council (Council).
2. Ensure that the number for the gate or grid is prominently displayed on the grid.
3. Maintain the grid, including all associated gates, fences, signs and surrounds in good order to ensure its safe use.
4. Take out and maintain, for the duration of the term of the Approval, a public liability insurance policy consistent with the standard public liability insurance condition, as that expression is defined in Subordinate Local Law No. 1, (Administration) 2019, section 6(c), and provide Council with a certificate of currency for the public liability insurance policy.
5. Reimburse Council for all costs incurred should Council deem it necessary to conduct urgent maintenance for safety purposes to the grid or the road approaches up to 5 metres from the grid.
6. Indemnify and keep indemnified Council its officers, employees, contractors, representatives and agents, for any cost, expense, damages, loss or liability borne out of any claim, suit, action, demand or proceedings made or brought against Council for which Council will or may be or become liable directly or indirectly arising from any loss or damage to property of, or injury including death or illness to, any person caused or contributed to by:
 - a) any wilful or negligent act or omission;
 - b) any non-compliance with any condition of the approval;
 - c) the undertaking of the prescribed activity, that is, carrying out works on a road or interfering with a road or its operation, and in particular, the operation of a grid on a road;
 - d) the use of the area on which the grid is situated or any area outside the area on which the grid is situated

by or on behalf of the approved Licence Holder or any individual acting through the approved Licence Holder, except to the extent that such loss, damage or injury was caused by Council or its employees, contractors, representatives, and agents.
7. Remove and destroy all declared noxious weeds and plants growing in the road reserve enclosed by the grid and up to a distance of 5 metres either side of the grid.
