



New food premises licensing process

Information on approvals, legislation requirements, inspections etc. have been collated below to provide you with an indicative timeline for licensing of a new food premises.

Stage	Required action
Pre-construction stage	Obtain relevant Food Business application forms from Council's website: www.frasercoast.qld.gov.au/food-business or call 1300 79 49 29.
	Obtain relevant approvals from other Council departments: Planning and Growth Building Section Plumbing Section
	Obtain relevant approvals from Wide Bay Water - Trade Waste section (e.g. grease interceptor).
	 Plan the design, construction and fit-out in accordance with: Food Safety Standard 3.2.3 'Food Premises and Equipment', and Australian Standard AS 4674-2004 'Design, Construction and fit-out of food premises'.
	Submit the ' <i>Application for approval to construct or refit premises'</i> and detailed plans to Environmental Health for approval prior to commencing any works.
Construction stage	Once approval for construction/refit is granted, you may commence building works on the premises, in accordance with approved plans and any conditions of approval.
	NOTE: This is not approval to start operating the business.
	Contact other statutory bodies for relevant information and licences as required (e.g. liquor licence, smoking laws, food labelling) as these approvals may take some time.
	Inspections may be arranged with Environmental Health to ensure works are being completed in accordance with the Conditions of Approval.
	Ensure the nominated Food Safety Supervisor has the required food safety competencies and other staff are suitably trained.
	Develop a Water Management Plan (to be approved by Council) and obtain a potable water analysis certificate if not using a town water supply.
	 A food business licence will be issued if: the construction or fit out of the food business is completed; and is in accordance with the approved plans and conditions of approval; and all relevant information has been provided (e.g. Food Safety Supervisor Certificate, Water Management Plan, Potable Water Analysis Certificate).
	If the proposed food business is to include Footpath Dining and/or Footpath Advertising contact Council's Community Rangers Section on 1300 79 49 29 for further information.
Final stage	Contact Council's Environmental Health Section at least 3 business days before the scheduled opening of the premises for trade to arrange a Final Inspection.
	Display the Food Licence publicly at the premises and start operating the business in accordance with the <i>Food Act 2006.</i>





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
