# Shopping Trolleys

Local Law No.3 (Community and Environment  
Management) 2011 - Part 7



Shopping trolleys left unattended or abandoned on roads, parks and waterways are unsightly and a potential threat to wildlife and the environment.

The intent of Local Law No. 3 Part 7 is to prevent shopping trolleys from being taken into public places.

## How does the Local Law affect you?

It is an offence for a person to take a shopping trolley from within a shopping centre precinct or leave a shopping trolley at a place outside a shopping centre precinct unless:

- the person takes or leaves the shopping trolley with the consent of the owner of the shopping trolley; or
- the person has a reasonable excuse.

An on-the-spot-fine can be issued to a person who removes and abandons a shopping trolley.
