



## ILLEGAL DUMPING UPDATE

There were 26 reportable illegal dumping incidents for the month of April. Green waste continues to be one of the most common illegally dumped waste materials in the Fraser Coast region. Illegal dumping of green waste introduces seeds, shoots, pests and weeds into our environment. Once these matters have established themselves, they lead to the degradation of the area and diminish its conservational value.

Green waste up to 4m<sup>3</sup> or 1 tonne in volume can be disposed of for free. Don't forget to ask for your loyalty card where you will receive one stamp for each visit. On your 8<sup>th</sup> trip with your green waste, you will be able to receive 1m<sup>3</sup> of standard or cottage mulch for free.

Let's ensure the "Polluter Pays" by dobbing in a dumper. It is easy to do and there are many ways to do it:
