



Breeding Cats & Dogs in the Fraser Coast – Fact Sheet



If you breed from your Cat or Dog in the Fraser Coast Region, whether it be male or female then you're considered a breeder under the local law and are required to hold a Fraser Coast Regional Council Animal Breeder Approval.

A breeder approval is designed to encourage cat & dog owners on the Fraser Coast to consider their responsibilities and ensure that the oversupply of cats & dogs and euthanasia rates are minimised.

APPLYING FOR A PERMIT

There are some criteria and additional mandatory documentation that may be required when applying, these can include but are not limited to:

- Dogs to be registered and microchipped.
- Cats to be microchipped.
- Owners of female dogs must have been issued a BIN (Supply Number) from the Department of Agriculture and Fisheries.*
**Having a BIN number does not automatically permit you to breed.*
- Written approval from a vet confirming the cat or dog is ready for breeding and has received all core vaccinations.
- Comply with the Breeder Code of Practice.

An application form along with Breeder Code of Practice is available on council's website. Application fees apply.

CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

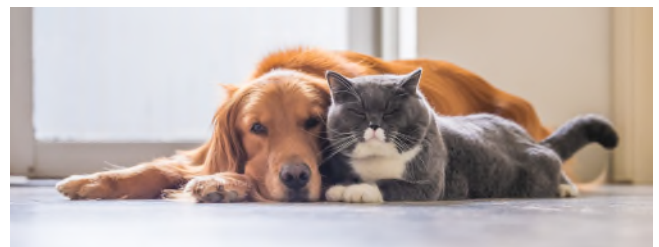
Once a breeding approval is granted there will be some conditions imposed. These can include but are not limited to:

- Kittens & Puppies must be sold **desexed & microchipped** unless an exemption exists.
- Notifying council within two weeks of having a litter and also when a progeny is sold. This is done by way of Breeder Record Form and Sale of Progeny Form.
- You must include your BIN (Supply Number) along with your Council Breeder Permit number in any advertisement. This is to identify approved breeders when you sell, give away or supply.
- Amendments need to be requested – refer to application form for details.
