

## **Updating the Fraser Coast Planning Scheme: Major Amendment Process**

## **COUNCIL-LED PROCESS**

## **STATE-LED PROCESS**

Council resolves to start the amendment process.

Council advises the State of the intention to make a major amendment to the planning scheme.

Council prepares the amendment and consults with relevant State agencies during the drafting process.

Council provides the proposed amendment changes and associated communication strategy associated to the Minister.

State identifies matters of state significance.

Minister reviews the proposed changes.

Council carries out public consultation on the proposed amendment changes.

Council considers submissions, responds to submissions and makes changes to the proposed amendment as necessary.

Council provides the revised amendment and submissions report to the Minister.

Council considers adopting the planning scheme amendment.

Council notifies the State Chief Executive of the adoption and commencement of the amendment.

Minister reviews the information and advises that Council may proceed to adoption, with or without conditions.
