

Kerb and Channel Replacement — Tanner Street (Alice Street to Edward Street)

PROJECT:

This project provides for the replacement of the existing kerb and channel and pavement reinstatement works on both sides of Tanner Street between Alice Street and Edward Street.

The kerb and channel works are being undertaken as a result of inspections carried out as part of Council's ongoing asset inspection program which identified that the kerb and channel was showing signs of failure and distress.

PROJECT ESTIMATE: \$220,000

PROJECT SCOPE OF WORKS:

- Removal and disposal of the existing kerb and channel;
- Earthworks and stormwater pit replacements with associated drainage works;
- Construction of new kerb and channel and pavement reinstatement;
- Reinstatement of driveway crossovers and kerb ramps;
- Reinstatement of disturbed verges.



The traffic management plan that will be put in place for the duration of the construction period will be developed prior to works commencing.
