Key Values

- Average score of 3.51 out of 5 for how it is valued on the survey (with 5 very highly valued)
- Respondents highly valued this locality for migratory bird resting sites, wetlands (feeding wader birds), fish habitat and mangroves and the environmental reserve (remnant vine forest)
- The Susan River homestead was valued for good access to recreational activities including canoeing and horse riding
- Important infrastructure for Fraser Island access (ferry) and recreation (picnic)
- River Heads is experiencing fine sediment entering the Great Sandy Strait
