

Sectional Replacement of Kerb and Channel Campbell Street (Morning St to Neptune St)

PROJECT:

This project provides for the replacement of sections of the kerb and channel in Campbell Street between Morning Street and Neptune Street. Sections to be replaced include 45 to 49 Campbell Street (northern side), 48 to 50 Campbell Street (southern side) and 39 Campbell Street to Neptune Street (northern side only).

The works are being undertaken as a result of inspections carried out as part of Council's ongoing asset inspection program which identified that the kerb and channel was showing signs of failure and distress.

PROJECT ESTIMATE: \$200,000

PROJECT SCOPE OF WORKS:

- Removal and disposal of the existing kerb and channel;
- Earthworks and stormwater pit replacements with associated drainage works;
- Construction of new kerb and channel and pavement reinstatement;
- Reinstatement of driveway crossovers and kerb ramps (reinstatement works to be completed in plain concrete only). Driveways that will be replaced as part of these works are located at 35, 37, 39, 45, 47 and 48 Campbell Street and 42 Neptune Street;
- Reinstatement of disturbed verges.




The traffic management plan that will be put in place for the duration of the construction period will be developed prior to works commencing.
