# How to register for your vaccination

Having a COVID-19 vaccine is your choice. It is free, safe and the best way to protect yourself and your loved ones from the serious illness or death from the virus. **Registration is the best way to secure a vaccination appointment.** 

## How to get vaccinated if you are under 50 or have priority eligibility

You are invited to register your interest to receive a COVID-19 vaccine at a Queensland Health vaccination location.

After you have registered, Queensland Health will email you when you are eligible, with instructions on how to select an appointment location and date that suits you. This email will give you instructions on how to select an appointment date that suits you.

If you are aged 50 or over you can book an appointment to get the COVID-19 vaccine at:

- general practitioner-led respiratory clinics
- general practices that meet specific requirements
- Aboriginal controlled community health services
- selected community pharmacies.
