Pier Park Lighting Replacement

PROJECT:

This project provides for the replacement of pathway lighting located within Pier Park, Urangan. Twentyeight light poles located around the Park will be removed with twenty-seven being replaced with upgraded poles. Five of the poles will be fitted with double pathway lights.

The project was identified for completion as the existing lighting system is deteriorated and beyond repair. The upgrading works will also bring the lighting up to current standards.

PROJECT ESTIMATE:

\$150,000

PROJECT SCOPE OF WORKS:

- Removal and disposal of existing lights, foundations and cables (existing conduits and pits to remain intact for reuse for new cables);
- Installation of new light poles and footings (Principal Supplied);
- Existing electrical pits and conduits to be retained and re-used where possible;
- Reinstatement of all existing vegetated and paved areas.



The pedestrian management plan that will be put in place for the duration of the construction period will be developed prior to works commencing. Works will be programmed to ensure no disruption occurs to the markets or park run that utilise Pier Park.
