

Happy Valley, Fraser Island — Plastic Track Pad Installation

PROJECT:

This project provides for Stage 1 works of a two staged project which allows for the installation of plastic track pads in Postan Street, Happy Valley, Fraser Island in the vicinity of the public toilets, carpark and shop facility.

The proposed works will minimise sand erosion, reduce maintenance and improve access to the facilities in this location.

The Stage 2 works will allow for the installation of plastic track pads from the existing timber pallet area to the south. Timing for the Stage 2 works are vet to be confirmed.

PROJECT ESTIMATE:

\$220,000 (Stage 1) (this project is funded by the State Government's Works for Queensland funding program)

PROJECT SCOPE OF WORKS:

The Project scope is as follows:

- Removal of sand;
- Placement of geofabic;
- Installation of plastic track pads;
- Placement of sand;
- Transition from wooden pallets to track pads.



The traffic management plan that will be put in place for the duration of the construction period will be developed prior to works commencing; however, these works will allow for traffic flow through the area whilst the works are completed.
