Dayman Street and Pulgul Street Intersection Upgrade

PROJECT:

This project provides for an upgrade of the Dayman Street and Pulgul Street intersection to assist with improving vehicular visibility and pedestrian safety at this intersection.

PROJECT ESTIMATE:

\$50,000

PROJECT SCOPE OF WORKS

The Project scope is as follows:

- Pedestrian refuge and chevron island at both legs of Dayman Street;
- No standing yellow lines at the corners and narrow lanes width;
- Turn lines at both legs of Dayman Street;
- Removal of the centreline along Pulgul Street and the inclusion of edge lines 3.3m away from the middle of the road;
- Reduction in speed limit from 60km/hr to 50 km/hr;
- On-street parallel formalised parking areas.



The traffic management plan that will be put in place for the duration of the construction period will be developed prior to works commencing.
