Pedestrian Refuge Crossing—Nissen Street

PROJECT:

This project provides for the construction of a pedestrian refuge crossing in Nissen Street in the vicinity of the Nissen Street and Bayswater Drive intersection.

The completion of these works will improve safety for cyclists and pedestrians.

PROJECT ESTIMATE:

\$103,000 (This project is partly funded through the Queensland Government’s Cycle Network Local Government Grants program.)

PROJECT SCOPE OF WORKS:

- General earthworks;
- 2x3.5m long pedestrian refuge islands;
- Construction of a raised blister island on the left turn to Bayswater Drive;
- New areas of footpath and kerb ramps;
- Street lighting, linemarking and signage.

The Contractors program will provide detail of traffic management for the duration of the construction period.
