

Elizabeth Street/Shell Street Intersection Upgrade

PROJECT:

This project provides for an upgrade of the Elizabeth Street and Shell Street intersection including the installation of single barrier lines, new concrete median island and pedestrian refuge, new give way signs and coloured threshold.

The completion of this project will provide for improved safety for users of this intersection.

PROJECT ESTIMATE:

\$185,000 (this project is funded through the Australian Government's Black Spot Program)

PROJECT SCOPE OF WORKS

The Project scope is as follows:

- Concrete median and pedestrian refuge;
- New asphalt and pavement;
- New stamped asphalt;
- New barrier kerb and kerb ramps x 4;
- New areas of concrete footpath;
- Lane markers;
- New linemarking and signage;
- Turfing to disturbed areas
