

Footpath and Kerb and Channel Construction

Cardigan Street and Arnaud Street

PROJECT:

This project provides for the construction of a 1.3m wide concrete footpath for a distance of 214m in Cardigan Street from the existing 1.5m wide concrete footpath to the existing bus stop in Arnaud Street. In addition, this project also allows for the construction of new kerb and channel for a distance of 92m to complete the missing section in Arnaud Street.

This project was identified for completion as part of Council's Active Travel Strategy.

PROJECT ESTIMATE:

\$235,000

PROJECT SCOPE OF WORKS:

- Concrete footpath construction;
- Kerb and channel construction;
- Upgrade of stormwater infrastructure;
- Pavement reinstatement in vicinity of new kerb;
- 2 new driveway crossovers at 165 Arnaud Street; (reinstatement works will be completed in plain concrete only)
- 2 x kerb ramps;
- Filling of area located inside 165 Arnaud Street to achieve required positive fall towards new kerb and channel;
- Replacement of fence and gate to accommodate new fill levels and replacement of approximately 4m of footpath within 165 Arnaud Street;
- Topdressing and turfing of disturbed areas.



The traffic management plan that will be put in place for the duration of the construction period will be developed prior to works commencing.
