

Replacement of Timber Decking — Moreton St, Toogoom Footbridge

PROJECT:

This project provides for the replacement of the existing timber decking, joists and handrails of the footbridge which provides access from the pathway located in Kingfisher Parade to Moreton Street, Toogoom. The timber decking will be replaced with recycled plastic decking composite material with the joists and handrails being replaced with timber material.

This project was identified for completion as a result of Council's ongoing asset inspection program.

PROJECT ESTIMATE:

\$100,000

PROJECT SCOPE OF WORKS:

The Project scope is as follows:

- Removal of timber decking, joists and hand rails;
- Installation of replacement decking, joists and hand rail materials.

The pedestrian management plan that will be put in place for the duration of the construction period will be developed prior to works commencing; however, it should be noted that the bridge will be closed Mondays to Fridays (open on weekends) during the completion of the deck replacement works.
