Footpath Construction—Ferry Street, Maryborough (Thomas Street to Alice Street)

PROJECT:

This project provides for the construction of a 1.3m wide concrete footpath on the western side of Ferry Street from existing pathway connections between Thomas Street and Alice Street.

This project was identified for completion as part of Council's Active Travel Strategy and will complete a missing footpath link in this location.

PROJECT ESTIMATE:

\$50,000

PROJECT SCOPE OF WORKS:

- Excavation and earthworks;
- Concrete footpath construction;
- Removal and replacement of sections of the two driveways that provide access to property located at 88-94 Ferry Street (*reinstatement works to be completed in plain concrete only*);
- Reconstruct kerb ramp that provides access to Thomas Street;
- Raising and re-installation of existing double post directional sign;
- Topdressing and turfing of disturbed areas.





INDICATIVE PROJECT MILESTONES


