

Footpath Replacement — Section of Burrum Heads Esplanade Pathway

PROJECT:

This project provides for the replacement of a 100m section of the existing paved footpath located along the Esplanade at Burrum Heads from the existing concrete footpath connection situated adjacent to the Burrum Heads Boat Ramp carpark towards Ross Street. The footpath will be replaced with a 1.3m wide concrete footpath.

This project is being completed following the identification of areas requiring replacement as part of Council's annual footpath inspection programme.

PROJECT ESTIMATE:

\$90,000

PROJECT SCOPE OF WORKS:

- · Removal and disposal of existing pavers;
- Excavation and preparation of subgrade;
- Concrete footpath construction;
- Topdressing and turfing of disturbed areas.



The traffic/pedestrian management plan that will be put in place for the duration of the construction period will be developed prior to works commencing.
