

PUBLIC NOTICE

*Local Government Act 2009*

1. Fraser Coast Regional Council (“Council”) has proposed to make *Local Government Controlled Areas Facilities and Roads (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2022* (the “amending subordinate local law”).
2. *Local Law No. 4 (Local Government Controlled Areas Facilities and Roads) 2011* authorises the making of the amending subordinate local law. The amending subordinate local law amends *Subordinate Local Law No. 4 (Local Government Controlled Areas Facilities and Roads) 2011*.
3. The purpose and general effect of the amending subordinate local law is to amend *Subordinate Local Law No. 4 (Local Government Controlled Areas Facilities and Roads) 2011* to remove the prohibition of riding, driving or using a personal mobility device (as that term is defined in the Schedule 8 *Transport Operations (Road Use Management – Vehicle Registration) Regulation 2010*) on all local government controlled footpaths.
4. Written submissions by any person in support of, or objecting to, the amending subordinate local law are invited during the period commencing on 31 October 2022 and ending on 25 November 2022 (the “consultation period”).
5. During the consultation period Council will make available for inspection and purchase at Council’s public offices at 77 Tavistock Street, Torquay or 211-213 Adelaide Street, Maryborough copies of the amending subordinate local law. Alternatively, copies of the amending subordinate local law will be available for viewing and download from Council’s website [www.frasercoast.qld.gov.au](http://www.frasercoast.qld.gov.au).
6. Submissions must be received on or before 25 November 2022 stating—
  - (a) the grounds of the submission; and
  - (b) the facts and circumstances relied on in support of the grounds.
