Code response to Acceptable Solutions for Self Assessable development

- (a) (i) N/A The proposed Medical Facility is within an existing building.
 - (ii) Car parking is provided along the street frontage and on site at the rear of the building.

Landscaping treatment of 2m wide exists along the road frontage.

- (b) Access, and car parking is provided in accordance with EDROC Standards. A total of 14 on site car parking spaces are provided, which equates to a rate of 1 space per 34m² of gross floor area. Sufficient room for service vehicles to load/unload is also provided to the rear of the site. One (1) space for PWD and an ambulance bay are located at the entrance to the site, while an additional 15 car parking spaces are also available along the street frontage in the immediate vicinity. Overall, the proposal can provide car parking in compliance with the required 1/25m².
- (c) (i) N/A
 - (II) The site is accessed by a constructed roadway with formalised stormwater drainage.
- (d) N/A There are no low impact industries associated with this proposal.

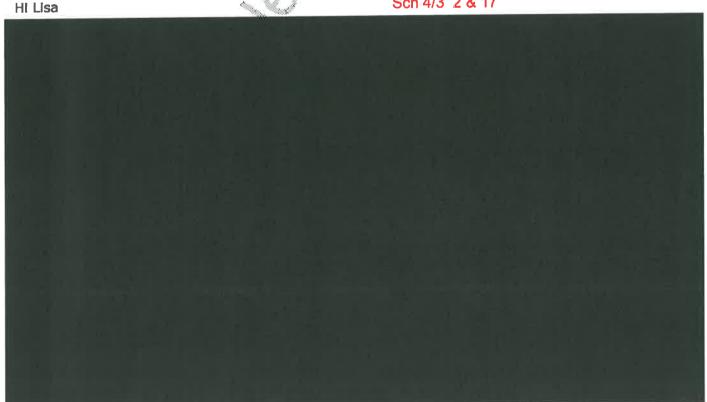

I am writing to advise that Council is inviting Expressions of Interest from yourself, as a former occupant of the former Tiaro Council building, and 2 other GPs who have since expressed interest in establishing a medical facility within the building. Following receipt of other offers, Council has revised the leasing conditions and is now willing to offer a 12 month rent free period subject to the following:-

- 1. The same offer will also be made to two other parties, each of whom have previously submitted EOIs requesting rent-free periods which were rejected by Council
- 2. The payment of outgoings e.g. electricity etc
- 3. A 5 year contract being executed, made up as follows:
 - 1. an initial period of 3 years, with the first year being rent free and the 2 subsequent years at \$100 per room per week
 - 2. a 2 year option subject to Council approval
- 4. Other terms and conditions being negotiated

Accordingly, can you please consider the above and if you wish to pursue this matter, please respond in writing, by no later than <u>Friday 18th October</u>, with your agreement to the above, and other terms and conditions you wish to include. If no response is received by the 18th Council will proceed on the basis that you do not wish to pursue the matter.

Upon receipt of all responses, the offers will be considered and you will be advised of the outcome as soon as possible.
