

Animal Desexing Rebate

FACTSHEET

Council is committed to reducing the number of unwanted cats and dogs within the Fraser Coast Regional Council area.

To assist, Council has adopted an Animal Desexing Reimbursement Incentive Policy. The incentive aims to target low-income earners to provide reimbursements associated with the costs for desexing a cat or dog.

Council will provide approved eligible persons with a reimbursement of \$50.00 for cats and \$100.00 for dogs that have recently been desexed.

Eligibility

To be eligible for a reimbursement you must be:

- A resident of the Fraser Coast Region; and
- An eligible holder of an approved Queensland Concession Card not limited to seniors, people with a disability, carers, sole parents, widows and students, Health Care or a Veteran Card; and
- The owner of a microchipped, desexed cat, or
- The owner of a microchipped, desexed dog that is registered (under 12 weeks of age exempt); and
- Have had the animal desexed within the last Sixty (60) days.

To Apply

Complete the Animal Desexing Reimbursement Application Form found on Council's website and submit with proof of current eligibility to one of Council's Customer Service Centres or via email – enquiry@frasercoast.qld.gov.au



Other Information

If your dog or cat is not microchipped, talk to the vet about getting your pet microchipped at the same time to ensure you meet the eligibility criteria.

An application for a dog must be made in the name of the registered owner of the dog who meets the eligibility requirements.

When an application is submitted Council will also update your dog's desexing status – this could have your dog registration fee reduced at the next renewal period.
