MAKING OF LOCAL LAWS WEBSITE NOTICE (NO. 6) 2023**

Title

1. This notice may be cited as the *Fraser Coast Regional Council Making of Local Laws Website Notice (No. 6) 2023* which has been issued pursuant to section 29B of the *Local Government Act 2009* (Qld).

Making of local laws

2. Fraser Coast Regional Council (the Council) has, by resolution dated 23 August 2023, made *Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2023* (the **Amending Subordinate Local Law**).
3. *Local Law No. 4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2011* authorises the Amending Subordinate Local Law to be made.
4. Upon making the Amending Subordinate Local Law, *Subordinate Local Law No. 4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2011* was amended.

Purpose and general effect of local law

5. The purpose of the Amending Subordinate Local Law is to—
 - (a) significantly reform the format and identification of prohibited and restricted activities in local government controlled areas;
 - (b) remove the prohibition of wheeled devices (or 'rideables') in certain areas to rely solely on State legislation for enforcement;
 - (c) add additional prohibited activities relating to public safety and vessels;
 - (d) transition to conditions of entry instead of local laws for rules of admission, creating a prohibited activity of 'contravening condition of entry'; and
 - (e) provide consistent wording regarding authorisations for restricted activities.

Commencement

6. The Amending Subordinate Local Law commenced on 1 September 2023.

Anti-competitive provisions

7. The Amending Subordinate Local Law does not contain anti-competitive provisions.

Adoption of consolidated version

8. Council has prepared and adopted a consolidated version of *Subordinate Local Law No. 4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2011* by resolution dated 23 August 2023 (the **Consolidated Subordinate Local Law**).

Inspection

9. A copy of the Amending Subordinate Local Law and Consolidated Subordinate Local Law may be—
 - (a) inspected at Council's public offices;
 - (b) purchased at Council's public offices; and
 - (c) viewed by the public on Council's website and the website of the Department of State Development, Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning.
