Fraser Coast Regional Council Subordinate Local Law No. 4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2011

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Part 1 Preliminary

1 Short title

This subordinate local law may be cited as Subordinate Local Law No. 4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2011.

2 Purpose and how it is to be achieved

- (1) The purpose of this subordinate local law is to supplement Local Law No.4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2011 in order to protect the health and safety of persons using local government controlled land, facilities, infrastructure and roads and preserve features of the natural and built environment and other aspects of the amenity of local government controlled land, facilities, infrastructure and roads.
- (2) The purpose is to be achieved by providing for—
 - (a) the regulation of access to local government controlled areas; and
 - (b) the prohibition or restriction of particular activities in local government controlled areas or roads; and
 - (c) the applicable minimum standards where owners are required to fence land adjoining a road.

3 Authorising local law

The making of the provisions in this subordinate local law is authorised by Local Law No.4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2011 (the authorising local law).

4 Definitions

- (1) Particular words used in this subordinate local law have the same meaning as provided for in the authorising local law.
- (2) In this subordinate local law—

animal has the meaning given in Local Law No. 2 (Animal Management) 2011.

aquatic equipment means—

- (a) an inflatable device or rubber or foam float or board that is not bathing equipment; or
- (b) a boogie board; or
- (c) a surfboard; or
- (d) a surf ski; or
- (e) a kayak; or
- (f) a canoe; or
- (g) another device for use on or in water to carry a person or thing across or through water or for recreational use in water and designed to be—
 - (i) paddled by a person; or

- (ii) ridden by a person on a wave or in a white water area; or
- (h) a vessel; or
- (i) a wind powered craft; or
- (j) another device specified by subordinate local law.

authorised in writing by an authorised person—

- (a) means that the action is authorised by a written authorisation signed by an authorised person; and
- (b) does not mean an approval mentioned in section 5(b) of *Local Law No.1 (Administration) 2011*.

authorised person has the meaning given in Local Law No. 1 (Administration) 2011.

bathing reserve has the meaning given in *Local Law No. 6 (Bathing Reserves)* 2011.

boat landing area includes a boat ramp, landing, jetty, pontoon, pylon, pier, queuing beach and set-down area which is the property of, or under the control of, the local government.

boat ramp—

- (a) means a ramp or other device or structure used or capable of use or designed or intended for use for the purpose of launching and retrieving a trailable vessel and which is the property of, or under the control of, the local government; and
- (b) includes any area of foreshore used or capable of use, for the purpose of launching and retrieving a trailable vessel and which is the property of, or under the control of, the local government.

building has the meaning given in the Building Act 1975.

camp, at a place, includes sleeping, occupying, or remaining overnight at the place.

caravan has the meaning given in Local Law No. 1 (Administration) 2011.

culvert means a drain, tunnel or channel crossing under a road or railway.

driver has the meaning given in the Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act 1995.

emergency vehicle has the meaning given in the authorising local law, section 6(7).

landing includes jetty, pontoon and wharf.

local government cemetery has the meaning given in *Local Law No. 1* (Administration) 2011.

park means a public place which the local government has, by resolution, set apart for park, recreational or environmental purposes, and includes land designated as a park in the planning scheme of the local government.

queuing beach means a designated stopping area adjacent to a boat ramp for the purpose of landing boats and other vessels prior to the use of a boat ramp.

reserve means land dedicated as a reserve, or granted in trust, under the *Land Act 1994* and for which the local government is a trustee under that Act and other land held in trust by the local government which the local government has, by resolution, set apart for recreational or environmental purposes, and includes land designated as a reserve in the planning scheme of the local government.

road has the meaning given in Local Law No. 1 (Administration) 2011.

set down area means a designated area for the setting down or picking up of passengers or goods in connection with boats and other vessels using the boat landing area.

service vehicle means a vehicle that is currently being operated by officers authorised by the local government or a State Government agency to conduct maintenance or servicing activities in a local government controlled area.

ship has the meaning given in the *Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Act* 1994.

structure has the meaning given in the Local Government Act 2009.

Tourist Park has the meaning given to it by the Planning Scheme.

trailable vessel means a vessel that is mounted on a trailer for road transport.

trailer has the meaning given in the Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act 1995.

vehicle has the meaning given in the Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act 1995.

vessel has the meaning given in the Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act 1995.

water storage area means any land which is dedicated as a reserve under the Land Act 1994 for drainage, the conveyance of storm water, flood prevention, flood mitigation or other similar purposes relating to water.'.

Part 2 Use of local government controlled areas, facilities and roads

5 Prohibited and restricted activities—Authorising local law, s 5

- (1) For section 5(1)(a) of the authorising local law, the activities prescribed in column 2 of schedule 1 are declared to be prohibited in the corresponding local government controlled area or road (or part thereof) mentioned in column 1 of schedule 1.
- (2) For section 5(1)(b) of the authorising local law, the activities prescribed in column 2 of schedule 2 are declared to be restricted in the corresponding local government controlled area or road (or part thereof) mentioned in column 1 of schedule 2, to the extent described in column 3 of schedule 2.

- (3) For section 5(4) of the authorising local law, the applicable penalty category for each prohibited activity in column 2 of schedule 1 is prescribed in column 3 of schedule 1.
- (4) For section 5(4) of the authorising local law, the applicable penalty category for each restricted activity in column 2 of schedule 2 is prescribed in column 4 of schedule 2.

6 Motor vehicle access in local government controlled areas—Authorising local law, s 6(1)(b)

For section 6(1)(b) of the authorising local law, the areas prescribed in column 1 of schedule 3 are declared to be motor vehicle access areas.

7 Prohibited vehicles—Authorising local law, s 6(3)

For section 6(3) of the authorising local law, the specific types of motor vehicle prescribed in column 2 of schedule 3 are declared to be prohibited vehicles in the corresponding specified motor vehicle access area in column 1 of schedule 3.
