

Road Reconstruction – James Street (Edwin St to Dayman St)

PROJECT:

This project provides for road reconstruction works in James Street between Edwin Street and Dayman Street, Hervey Bay.

The road reconstruction works are being undertaken as a result of Council's ongoing asset inspection program which identified that the road was showing signs of pavement failure and distress.

PROJECT ESTIMATE:

\$250,000

PROJECT SCOPE OF WORKS:

The project scope is as follows:

- Excavation and earthworks;
- Road reconstruction works including new asphalt surfacing;
- Replacement of sections of existing kerb and channel (2-4 James Street, 8 to 10 James Street, and 6 Dayman Street to part of 3-5 James Street):
- Reconstruction of existing vehicle crossovers at 2 James St, 4 James St x 2, 8 James St, 10 James St x 2, 6 Dayman Street and 3-5 James St x 2. (reinstatement works will be completed in plain concrete only)
- Stormwater drainage works;
- Linemarking, topdressing and turfing of disturbed areas.



The traffic management plan that will be put in place for the duration of the construction period will allow for a one lane/one way traffic arrangement with traffic travelling in a southerly direction.
