A	The place is important in demonstrating the evolution or pattern of the region's history
Statement	The Federal Theatre is important in demonstrating the evolution and pattern of the region's history, particularly the growth of Howard as a consequence of coal mining and the need for entertainment.
В	The place demonstrates rare, uncommon or endangered aspects of the region's cultural heritage
Statement	The Federal Theatre demonstrates a rare aspect of the region's cultural heritage, as small, regional town theatres are uncommon in the region.
D	The place is important in demonstrating the principal characteristics of a particular class of cultural places important to the region
Statement	The Federal Theatre is important in demonstrating the principal characteristics of a small, regional town theatre constructed in the early twentieth century.
