Historical Context	Set originally in 2 ha police paddock which is still retained. The Court House is now used as the Police Station.			
Physical Description	COURT HOUSE: T-shaped building; low set on modern concrete and metal stumps. Asymmetrical gable iron roof with skillion awning over front verandah. Timber frame, external studs, 4 horizontal chamfer board tongue and groove internal cladding. Wide verandahs on three sides, originally with no verandah rail. Modern double rail balustrade. Sash windows; window shades. LOCK UP: External detached lockup and another shed – possibly harness shed. Small rectangular building with annex on front. Lowset on timber stumps. Gable iron roof. Double front door. RESIDENCE: Adjacent asymmetrical nested porch bungalow c1930. Gable iron roof. Timber frame; chamferboard external cladding. Front verandah enclosed with decorative lattice work; window shades with decorative fretwork on sides of shade.
