

Bus Stop Upgrades – Yarrilee School, Hervey Bay and Kingfisher Parade, Toogoom

PROJECT:

This project provides for the following upgrades of bus stops on footpaths in the vicinity of the following locations:

- Scrub Hill Road (Yarrilee School)—removal of two (2) x existing slabs and construction of two (2) x new bus shelters and slabs
- Kingfisher Parade (Morris Road—East), Toogoom — removal of existing slab and construction of a new bus shelter and slab

Project locations and specific detail relative to the works to be undertaken at each site is attached.

These projects were identified for completion as part of projects to be delivered through the Passenger Transport Accessible Infrastructure Program.

PROJECT ESTIMATE:

\$125,000 (These projects are partly funded through the Queensland Government's Passenger Transport Accessible Infrastructure and Works for Queensland Funding Programs)

PROJECT SCOPE OF WORKS:

The project scope is as follows:

- Excavation and earthworks;
- Demolition of concrete slabs and construction of new concrete slabs;
- Installation of bus shelters;
- Linemarking and signage;
- Topdressing and turfing of disturbed areas.

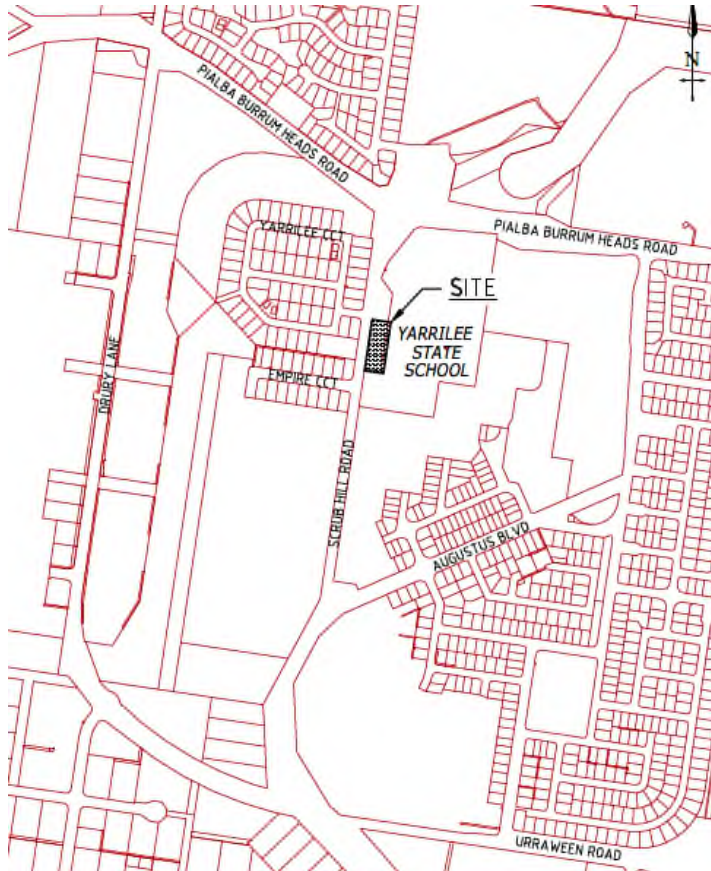
The traffic and pedestrian management plans that will be put in place for the duration of the construction periods will be developed prior to works commencing.
