

## MARYBOROUGH SHOWGROUNDS GENERAL CAMPING AREA CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND USE

- Maryborough Showgrounds and Equestrian Park is a designated rest stop. Stays are limited to 72 hours (not relating to an event);
- A maximum of six (6) people, including children and infants, are allowed per site. Additional people will require a further site booking;
- Parents/guardians are responsible for their children's safety and behaviour at all times. Children under the age of twelve (12) years of age must be accompanied by an adult to amenities and all recreation areas;
- Guests under the age of 18 years of age are not permitted to make a booking or stay overnight at this venue unaccompanied by an adult;
- For the safety and considerations of all patrons, Maryborough Showgrounds and Equestrian Park is a glass free venue;
- Camping and parking of vehicles are allowed in designated areas only;
- Roping off/reserving sites in designated camping areas is prohibited;
- Open fires/fire pits are not permitted within the venue;
- Venue Speed limit is strictly 20km per hour. All roads within our venue are shared roadways with pedestrians and livestock.
  Speed limits are to be observed at all times;
- General waste and recycling bins are to remain at allocated locations throughout the venue; and are not to be moved to individual camp sites;
- All grey water is to be disposed in the designated drains and dump points only;
- Dogs are permitted in the venue and must remain on a lead at all times. Loose dogs will be impounded;
- Off leash facilities are available in our dedicated off leash dog area and must be supervised;
- Dogs are not permitted in any horse areas as signed;
- No horses are permitted in the general camping area at any time;
- Noise; the peaceful enjoyment of our venue is important to our guests. Please assist by being considerate to others and restrict noise from radios, televisions and social gatherings after 9.00pm;
- Any illegal activities or disruptive behaviour will be reported to Police and you will be evicted from the venue;
- Security; venue staff do their best to ensure a safe, secure environment and recommend all valuables are secured at all times;
- Evacuation; Please make yourself familiar with nearest emergency assembly point. In the unlikely event of an evacuation make your way calmly to the designated emergency assembly point;
- Emergency; In the event of an emergency please call 000.
