Common name:	Hoop pines x 10 and Kauri pine x 1
Botanical name:	<i>Araucaria Cunninghamii</i> and <i>agathis robusta</i>
Origin:	Planted endemic
Municipality:	Pialba (QLD)
Location:	Corner McLiver Street and Davis Drive
Significances:	<p>Historical Value – memorial trees for lives lost in defence service, documented ceremonial trees, trees planted by global leaders, or trees that can be linked to the region's earlier botanical planters or documented local history;</p> <p>Landscape Value- a local landmark or feature, significance in size, form and spread in a regional context and contributes to the scenic character of location or setting;</p>

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This stand of trees is within the property boundary of the first European property owner, the Davis family. Being on an elevated site they present a landmark within the Pialba area and also serve as an entry statement into the development. A stand of this species and of this age is rare within the Hervey Bay area.
