2024/25 CONDITIONS FOR ACCESS TO WATER FILLING STATIONS

THIS FORM IS TO BE READ PRIOR TO APPLYING FOR 'ACCESS TO WBW - WATER FILLING STATIONS' APPLICATION FORM 2024/25.

- Access to WBW potable water filling stations will be by use of an electronic tag system.
- 2. Eight potable water filling stations have been established at:
 - Arnaud St, Granville

- Morris Road, Toogoom
- Averial Close, Dundowran Industrial Estate River Heads Road, Booral
- Elevated water tower, Forgan Terrace, Tiaro Showgrounds, Maryborough
- Elevated water tower, William St. Howard
- Central Road, Tinana
- A tag will be issued to applicants upon all of the appropriate documentation being completed. Only one tag per 3. account will be issued and is not transferable
- The prepaid tag must only be used at the registered property on the application. 4.
- The property must be within the Fraser Coast Regional Council Region and must not have a water meter 5. already connected to the property to be applicable to sign up as a non-commercial user.
- Charges apply for the amount of water supplied. Charges are automatically debited by the pre-paid 6. electronic tag.
- 7. The applicant is required to prepay for a specified amount of water on the tag at the current rate of \$6.00 per kilolitre
- The WBW Tag fee is non-refundable and applies to new, replacement and damaged tags. The tag fee for 8. the 2024/25 financial year is set at \$50.00.
- 9. Payment for topping up credit can be arranged by phoning 1300 79 49 29 or by visiting the following offices between business hours 8.15am - 4.00pm

Hervey Bay - Wide Bay Water, 29-31 Ellengowan Street, Urangan.

Maryborough – Fraser Coast Regional Council, 211-213 Adelaide Street, Maryborough.

- Training can be provided on use of the tag and the filling station operation. 10.
- The applicant shall be held responsible for the cost of any repairs of damage caused by the incorrect use of equipment at the filling station.
- 12. The applicant is required to purchase a "Female QLD Fire Hydrant Fitting" to connect to the water filling stations
- Any damage to tags or equipment must be reported to Wide Bay Water within 24 hours. 13.
- 14. Failure to comply with all of the conditions listed above may result in the electronic tag being canceled

Please be aware that:

- \cdot You "MUST" connect your hose to the Fill Station as well as your truck/container before inserting the Tag.
- Once you insert the Tag, it automatically opens the Fill Station valve and begins pumping water.
- · When the display reaches the \$ amount or litres you require, please remove your tag. The fill station will continue to release water until this volume is dispensed. Fill Stations dispense in 100 litre increments.
- · For smaller water containers, please remove the tag when your container is 100 litres from being full. Note: Tag removal does not immediately stop water flow.
- · Non-Commercial Tags have a weekly limit of 7000L (7kL) and will reset at 23:59 Wednesday night. If further limit is required, please submit request in writing.
- · When carting water it is essential to follow the TMR guidelines for your vehicle. Website: https://www.tmr.qld.gov.au/
- If you are caught on selling water you will be disconnected from the water filling station service.
