

Road Reconstruction —Queens Road (Boat Harbour Drive to Torquay Road)

PROJECT:

This project provides for road reconstruction works in Queens Road between Boat Harbour Drive and Torquay Road. Works also include the construction of a new water main.

This project was identified for completion as part of Council's road reconstruction prioritisation process due to the road's current condition level.

PROJECT ESTIMATE:

\$1.4M

PROJECT SCOPE OF WORKS:

- Excavation and earthworks;
- Pavement rehabilitation works including new asphalt surfacing;
- Kerb and channel replacement;
- Reconstruction of vehicle crossovers (reinstatement works will be completed in plain concrete only);
- Water main replace works;
- Concrete island infills at the East Street/Queens Road intersection
- Kerb ramps
- Linemarking;
- Topdressing and turfing of disturbed areas.



The traffic management plan that will be put in place for the duration of the construction period will allow for a one lane, one-way traffic arrangement with traffic travelling in a southerly direction.
