

Tooth Street and Old Maryborough Road Intersection Signalisation

PROJECT:

This project provides for the installation of traffic signals at the corner of Tooth Street and Old Maryborough Road, Hervey Bay.

The completion of this project will provide for improvements to traffic performance as well as pedestrian safety during peak periods.

PROJECT ESTIMATE:

\$3.6M (this project is funded through the State Government's Works for Queensland Funding Program)

PROJECT SCOPE OF WORKS:

The project scope is as follows:

- Excavation and earthworks;
- Installation of traffic signals at each leg of the intersection of Old Maryborough Road and Tooth Street, Pialba, including two signal crossing points (one in Tooth St and one in Old Maryborough Road);
- Road widening to accommodate turn movements;
- New areas of 2.5m wide concrete footpath at each intersection leg;
- New bicycle on and off ramps on all legs of the intersection;
- 1.5m on road bike lanes;
- New kerb and channel;
- New centre medians;
- Stormwater drainage;
- Areas of new pavement and surfacing works;
- New Driveway crossovers at 4 Darby Court and 39 x 2, 41 & 45 Old Maryborough Road;
- Lighting and water main upgrades;



PROJECT SCOPE OF WORKS (CONTD)

- Removal of trees;
- Linemarking;
- Topdressing and turfing of disturbed areas.

The traffic and pedestrian management plan that will be put in place for the duration of the construction period will be developed prior to works commencing; however, it should be noted that some changed traffic conditions will be required as part of the delivery of this project.
