

Reconstruction of Existing Footpath – Robert Street

PROJECT:

This project provides for the replacement of a 160 metre section of footpath in Robert Street in front of the Urangan State High School with a 2.5m wide concrete footpath.

The footpath project was identified for replacement as part of Council's footpath inspection program.

PROJECT ESTIMATE:

\$150,000 (this project is partly funded through the State Government's Transport Infrastructure Development Scheme)

PROJECT SCOPE OF WORKS:

The project scope is as follows:

- Excavation and earthworks;
- Reconstruction of an existing 160m section of footpath to allow for the construction of a 2.5m wide concrete footpath on the eastern side of Robert Street in front of the Urangan State High School to connect to existing paths in this location;
- Topdressing and turfing of disturbed areas.



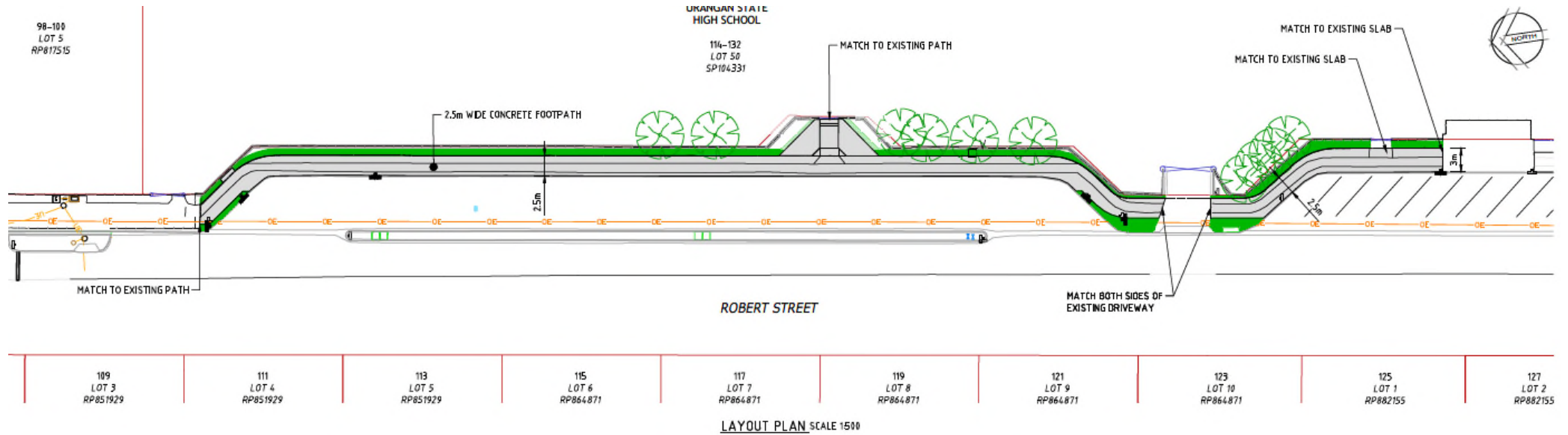
The traffic and pedestrian management plan that will be put in place for the duration of the construction period will be developed prior to works commencing.


