

Fraser Coast Sports Precinct Complex – Construction of Internal Service Road Facilities

PROJECT:

This project provides for the construction of a section of bitumen road, turf reinforcement matting and footpath construction to improve access in and around existing sporting infrastructure within the Fraser Coast Sports Precinct Complex.

The works are being undertaken to improve accessibility whilst protecting surfaces within the Sports Precinct.

PROJECT ESTIMATE:

\$700,000 (this project is funded through the State Government's Works for Queensland Funding Program)

PROJECT SCOPE OF WORKS:

The project scope is as follows:

- Excavation and earthworks;
- Replacement of an existing gravel access road from the carpark area to the end of the first premium football field with a bitumen surface;
- Installation of turf reinforcement matting from the end of the bitumen access road to the maintenance shed located adjacent to the new basketball facility;
- Construction of two concrete path areas from the northern staircase areas of the football amenities buildings;
- Topdressing and turfing of disturbed areas.
